Includes: Preliminary treatment, primary treatment, biological trickling filters, secondary treatment, nitrification aeration, final clarification, sand filters, chlorination, disinfection and dechlorination.

TREATMENT PLANT PERFORMANCE

During the twelve-month period from January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013, total flow for the wastewater treatment plant was 1,319,638,000 gallons.

During the period from January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013, the City of Asheboro experienced three (3) overflow events at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, four (4) overflow events from lift stations and eleven (11) overflow events from the collection system. This amounted to a total of 12,220 gallons of wastewater overflow from lift stations and the wastewater treatment plant and 95,000 gallons overflowing from manholes, which represents only 0.0008 percent of the total flow treated for this calendar year.
