RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. This permit will be valid until midnight on December 31, 2015.
2. Kayak rack spaces will be assigned on a "first come-first served" basis.
3. The fee is \$60/year for City-Residents (with a current Rec-Card) or \$85/year for Non-Residents.
4. Only one (1) rack space will be rented per kayak owner.
5. Lake access permits and rack spaces are non-transferable.
6. Maximum kayak size is 12' in length.
7. Kayak owners should keep their craft in a safe, operable, and aesthetically pleasing condition.
8. The kayak must be placed on the rack in a manner that does not interfere with easy access to crafts in other racks or pose a hazard to other rack users or their property.
9. Kayaks must be stored upside down.
10. Owners are required to, and are responsible for, securing their craft to the racks with a lock.
11. Kayaks can only be stored on the racks. Any craft found in the area that is not secured in a rack will be removed at the owners' expense.
12. Kayaks are subject to reassignment of rack spaces at the judgment of the Recreation Services Department.
13. Failure to occupy the rack space for at least six (6) months out of the year will result in losing the assigned space in the future.
14. Kayak owners may not alter the storage rack in any manner. If alterations or damages occur, the renter will forfeit their space, fees paid and will be responsible for paying for those damages.
15. Upon receipt of permit, you may put your kayak in it's assigned space on a rack.
16. A complete list of Lake Rules & Regulations is available at Lake Lucas and Asheboro Cultural & Recreation Services.
17. Failure to follow these rules and regulations or to maintain proper appearance of your kayak will result in automatic forfeiture of space & fees.

By signing below I attest to having read and understand this entire application and hereby apply to store and use my kayak on Lake Lucas. If I am granted a permit, I agree to abide by all rules and regulations governing the operation of kayaks on the lake. I completely understand that violation of the Rules & Regulations will result in forfeiture of my rental rack space, forfeiture of fees paid and lake privileges being revoked. I understand that the City of Asheboro, it's employees and/or it's independent contractors cannot be held responsible for lost, damaged or stolen property. I understand that all city residents need to first obtain a Rec-Card to receive city rate discounts and to obtain said Rec-Card I must do so in person at the Asheboro Cultural & Recreation Services Department. I understand that failure to use my correct residential address on this application will result in this application not being processed.
