Fire Chief

(Fire Department)

An employee in this class is responsible for planning, organizing and directing the operation of a Fire Department and for being an effective administrator of all fire programs, including personnel training and care of department equipment and physical properties. The incumbent makes budget recommendations and promotes fire prevention programs and favorable public relations. An employee in this class is responsible for the overall direction of firefighting operations and activities at scenes of fires. Work is performed under general direction of the City Manager and is governed by city and state laws. Work is reviewed by reports and evaluated in conference with the Mayor and Council and the City Manager.

Minimum Experience and Training

Extensive experience in all phases of municipal firefighting and fire prevention activities, including extensive experience in a supervisory capacity or any equivalent combination of experience and training. The individual should possess significant fire operations and fire management experience in organizations serving populations of 20,000 or more. The individual's work history must demonstrate successful fulfillment of progressively higher levels of responsibility culminating in a role equivalent to fire chief or a top deputy/assistant. A BA/BS degree is required. The City seeks a fire safety leader with a minimum of 5 years at the Battalion Chief Rank with progressive fire safety experience and a minimum of 5 years of cross-functional and progressively responsible experience including fire suppression, prevention, EMS and administrative work.

Special Requirements

Possession of a valid Class B license issued by the State of North Carolina and a have a safe driving record. Must live within the zoning district of the City of Asheboro.

Physical Requirements

Must be able to perform heavy work exerting up to 100 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 50 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 20 pounds of force constantly to move objects. Must be able to work at heights and in confined spaces. Works outdoors in varying weather conditions.

Starting Salary: The hiring range is \$79,927 to \$89,918, depending on qualifications and experience.
