ASHEBORO, NC – The City of Asheboro’s Redevelopment Commission has a vacant seat and is soliciting applications from individuals who are interested in serving an unexpired term through March, 2018. The Commission largely serves a supporting and advisory role to the Asheboro City Council.

“The Redevelopment Commission carries out a broad variety of duties,” said Community Development director, Trevor Nuttall. “The Commission provides valuable direction to city staff regarding enforcement of the minimum housing code, participates in the preparation of redevelopment proposals and advises the City Council on matters the Commission believes are important to the health and welfare of Asheboro.”

Participation on the Redevelopment Commission is voluntary and does require time, energy and commitment. An appointment is expected to be made in the next 90 days.
