ABC Board Vacancy

The City of Asheboro is accepting applications from individuals who would like to serve on the local Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) board. The individual selected will be appointed for a three-year term of office. A current member of the board has chosen not to seek reappointment, and will end their term of office on August 12, 2012.

The Asheboro ABC Board operates the retail ABC store located at 700 South Fayetteville Street and meets monthly. The Board is a local independent political subdivision of the State of North Carolina. It operates as a separate entity, establishing its own policies and procedures, and it retains authority to set policy and adopt rules in conformity with NC ABC Laws and the NC Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission Rules.

Anyone interested in applying for this board position should obtain an Interest Form for Service on Boards and Commissions from the City's web site (www.asheboronc.gov) or through the Planning and Zoning office in City Hall. Applications and resumes should be returned to the City Clerk in City Hall by no later than 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 21.
