## **City of Asheboro Extraterritorial Planning Jurisdiction (ETJ) Joint Staff Public Information Session with Randolph County Planning Department**

The City of Asheboro is considering **reducing** the extent of its ETJ area to better manage land use within its jurisdiction. The ETJ is an area outside of the City Limits that is subject to City land development regulations. **Property owners that may be affected by a change have received a notification in the mail.**

The Asheboro Planning & Zoning Department will hold a joint staff public information session with the Randolph County Planning Department on November 29, 2012 to allow citizens to review proposed maps and ask questions. The session will take place between the hours of 6:00 and 8:00 p.m. at the Asheboro Public Works Facility located at 1312 N. Fayetteville Street.
