Just in time for Memorial Day Weekend.... City of Asheboro reminds residents of Rec-Card Opportunity and Benefits

The City of Asheboro reminds residents, who currently live in the City Limits, that they are eligible for a free City Rec Card. The Rec Card entitles holders to City Resident Rates at the Municipal Golf Course, Lake Lucas, Lake Reese, Memorial Pool, North Asheboro Park Pool and various Recreation programs. City pools open this Saturday, May 25th at 12:00 and will be open Memorial Day.

As an added benefit, card holders can also access the Randolph-Asheboro YMCA for a fee of \$2.50 per visit as follows:

- Visit the YMCA's Splash Pad on Wednesdays from 4:00 – 6:45 pm, Saturdays from 8:00 am – 4:00 pm and Sundays from 1:00 – 3:00 pm.
- Swim in the YMCA pool during the months of August – May on Saturdays from 1:00 – 4:45 pm and Sundays from 2:00 – 4:45 pm.
- Visit the gymnasium for basketball on Saturdays from 8:00 am – noon (year round). The gym will also be available on Wednesdays from 6:00 am – noon and 8:00 – 10:00 pm from May 1 – November 30.

Rec Cards are valid for one year and are available at the Cultural and Recreation Services Office located at 241 Sunset Avenue. In order to be eligible, residents must present a valid government issued ID with a current address as well as a current bill (within the month) that displays a street address.
