

## PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO VISION DRIVE (SR 2269)

At the request of the City of Asheboro, the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) proposes to make safety improvements to Vision Drive (SR 2269) that include a new directional crossover, additional turn lane storage, and changes to the existing median crossover. Current plans for the improvements call for adding the directional crossover approximately 500 feet west of the driveway serving Hospice of Randolph County (Hospice) and the Carolina House. The directional crossover will allow motorists exiting Hospice, the Carolina House and Woodland Hill Care and Rehabilitation (Woodland) to access the eastbound lanes of Vision Drive in a safe and controlled manner. As a part of the safety improvements, left turn movements from Woodland onto Vision Drive will be redirected to the new directional crossover. A small amount of additional right-of-way may be required for the project, but no impact to homes or businesses is anticipated due to right-of-way acquisition.
