Chief Building Inspector

(Inspections Department)

An employee in this class is responsible for enforcing strict adherence to city and state codes, laws and ordinances by building and related tradesmen and may supervise inspectors who carry out specialized inspection activities. The work requires interpretation of codes and ordinances and recommendations for revisions. Work is performed both independently and collaboratively with the Deputy City Clerk and is evaluated through reports and observations by the Community Development Director.

Minimum Experience and Training

Graduation from high school supplemented by courses in structure design or architecture. Extensive experience in building, heating and ventilation, electrical and plumbing inspection or any equivalent combination of experience and training.

Special Requirements

A minimum of Level 3 Probationary certification in Building, Plumbing, Mechanical and Electrical is required, and the ability to obtain Standard Level 3 certification in these trades within 2 years from date of hire. An applicant currently possessing a combination of Level 2 and Level 3 certifications may be considered, with the ability to obtain Standard 3 in Building, Plumbing, Mechanical and Electrical within 2 years from date of hire. Must possess a valid North Carolina driver's license and a safe driving record.

Physical Requirements

Must be able to lift 20 to 50 pounds. Incumbent sometimes works near electrical current and must be able to climb, crawl, crouch, see close and see color. May work outdoors in varying weather conditions.
