6. Mr. Steve Hackett, CPA with the firm of William R. Huneycutt, CPA will present the year-end audit report for fiscal year 2018-2019.
7. Chairman Mac Pugh and CEO Angie Orth of Randolph Health will update the city council on the application for Rural Health Care Stabilization Funding.
8. Consent agenda:

  - (b) Community Development Director Trevor Nuttall will discuss the vacancy created by the recent resignation of a planning board member.
