1. Call to Order

A quorum thus being present, Mayor Smith called the meeting to order for the transaction of business, and business was transacted as follows.

2. On-Site Status Report and Review of the Zoo City Sportsplex Construction Project

After calling the meeting to order, Mayor Smith asked City Manager John Ogburn to provide an overview of the Zoo City Sportsplex site and construction project. Prior to discussing the construction work in greater detail, Mr. Ogburn recognized former Mayor Jarrell and contractor Terry Tucker.

During the discussion of the status/progress of the construction work, City Engineer Michael Leonard, PE provided a technical overview of the work that has been completed and the work that remains. The targeted opening date for phase 1 of the project is Labor Day weekend.

When the city manager and city engineer completed the overview, the council members split into groups of no more than three council members per utility vehicle in order to tour the sportsplex premises. Upon the completion of the individual tours, the council members reassembled with Mayor Smith at the location where they initially gathered at the beginning of the special meeting.

During the course of the special meeting, no action was asked of the council, and none was taken.
