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At 8:15 a.m. on Monday, November 18, 2024, the Asheboro City Council will convene for a special meeting at the Martha Luck Comer Conference Center on the Asheboro campus of Randolph Community College, 629 Industrial Park Avenue, Asheboro, North Carolina 27205. The purpose of the special meeting is to enable the city council to interview applicants for the city manager position. These interviews will be conducted in closed sessions pursuant to Section 143-318.11(a)(6) of the North Carolina General Statutes.

The Piedmont Triad Regional Council ("PTRC") is assisting with the city manager recruitment and evaluation process. During the special city council meeting, PTRC representatives will facilitate applicant interviews conducted by the elected officials.

This round of interviews will span two days. After the last interview of the day on November the 18th, the special city council meeting will be recessed until the next day. The interviews scheduled for this round of the evaluation process will conclude on November 19, 2024.

No final appointment decision will be made during the special meeting. The only open session meeting agenda items will be calling the meeting to order and acting on motions to go into closed session, recess, and adjourn.
