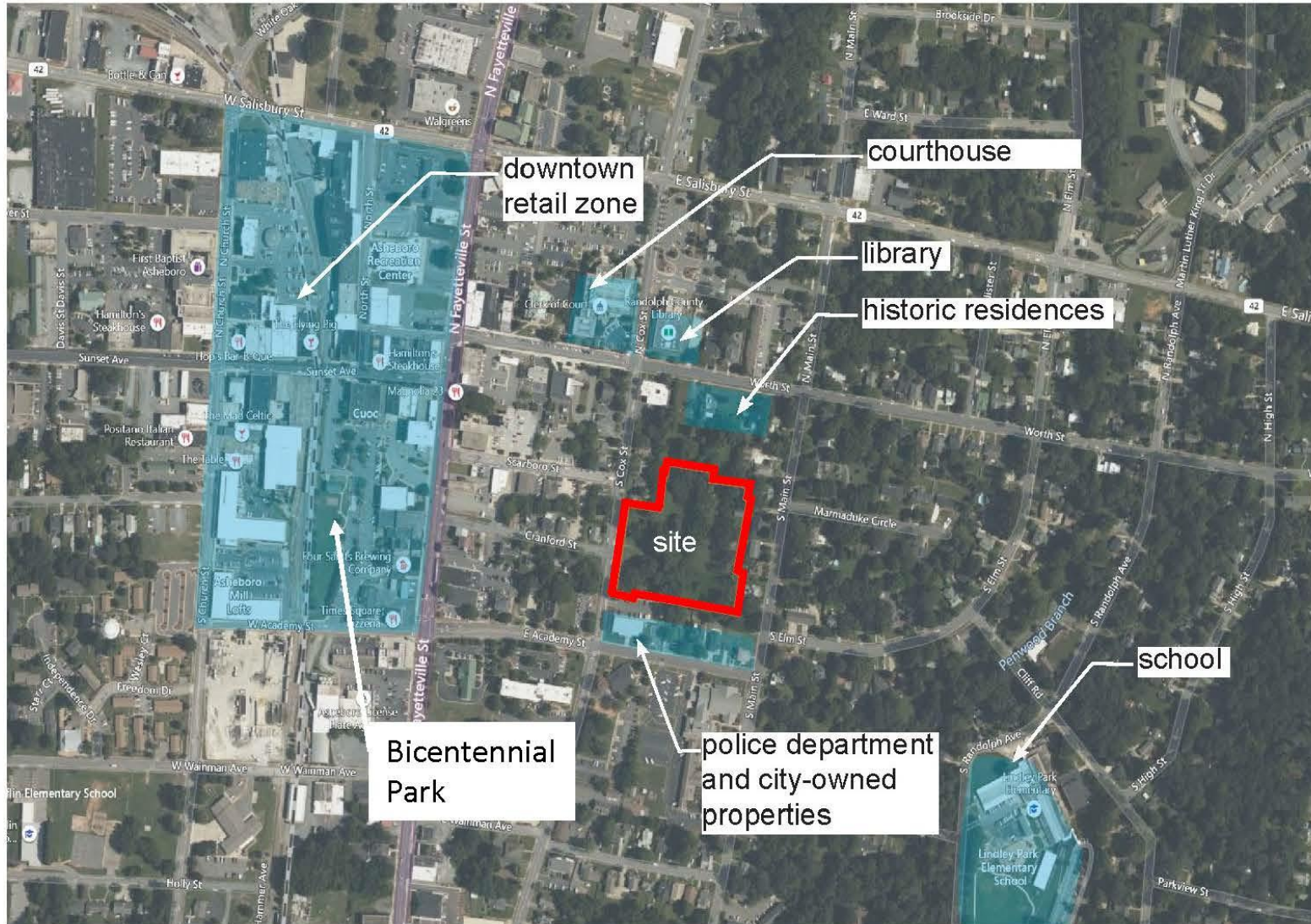

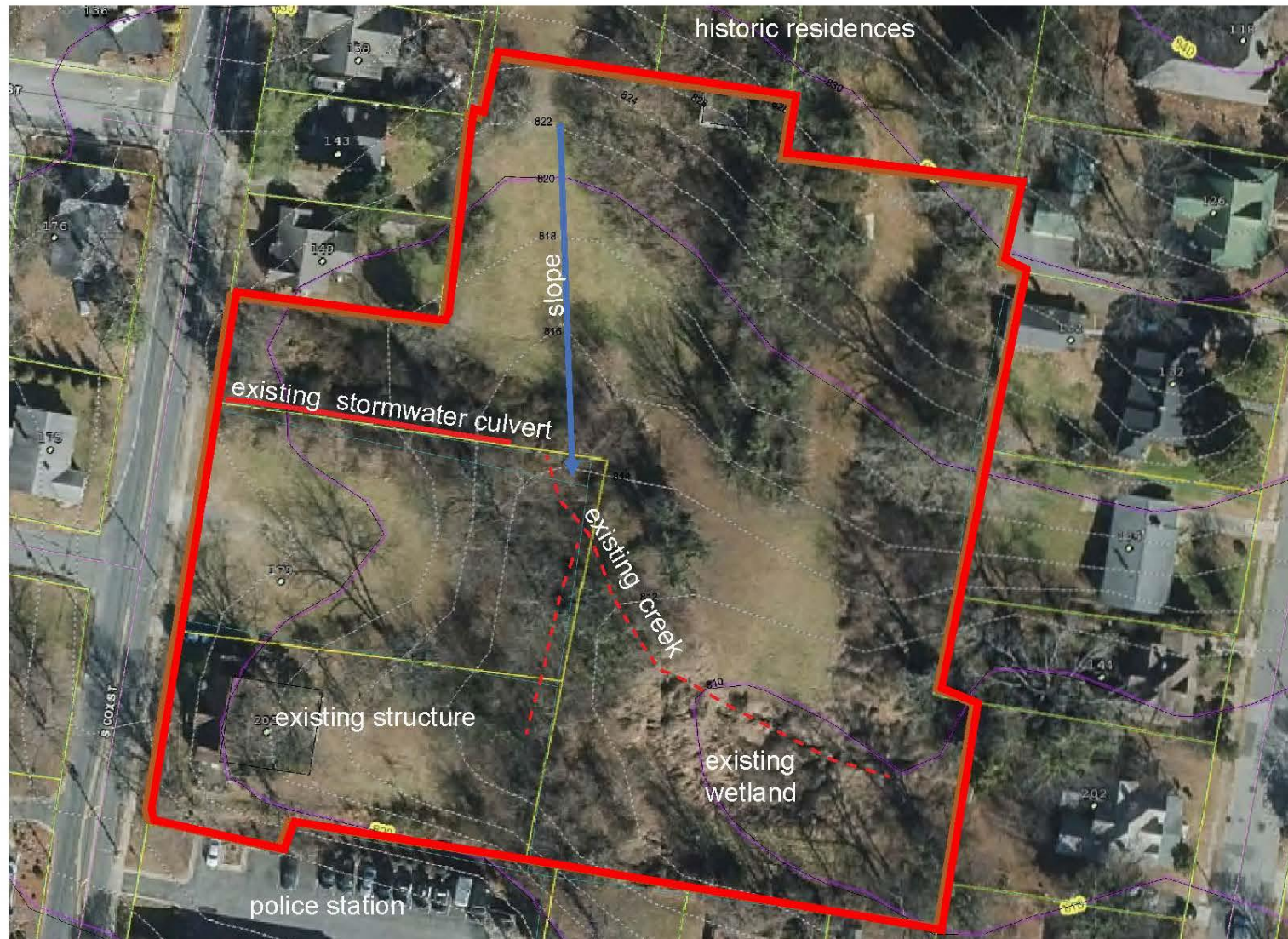

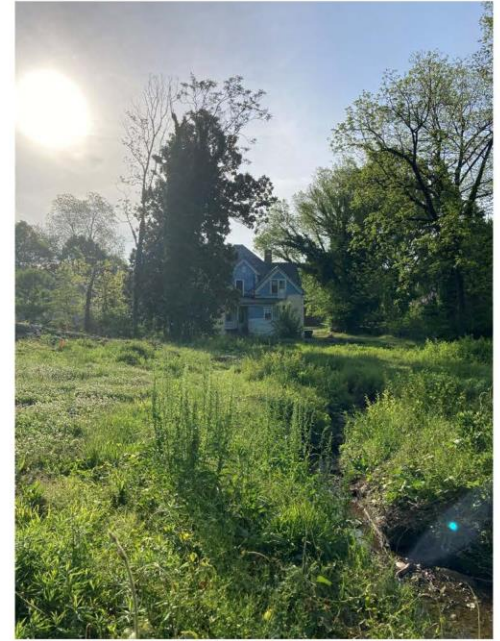
Site Vicinity / Location

Programming for Site: Stakeholder Mtg 1

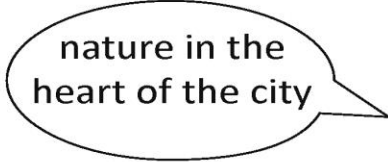
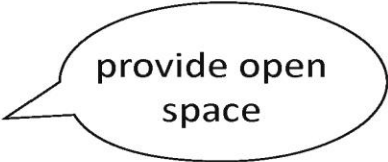
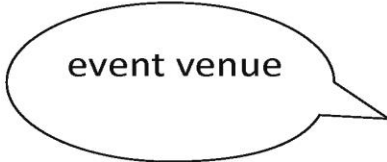
April 2021

- Bird and wildlife attracting plants
- Fragrant plants
- Different Gardens: apiary, bog, butterfly, rose, shade
- ADA path system
- Places to sit
- Water features
- Gazebo or pavilion – possible small wedding venue
- Parking for approx. 24-30
- Restrooms, hydration stations, emergency call box
- Power for events and possible holiday light show
- Lighting for safety, path, parking
- Water for drinking and irrigation
- Potentially use existing home onsite for visitor center
- Be mindful of the wetlands on site.

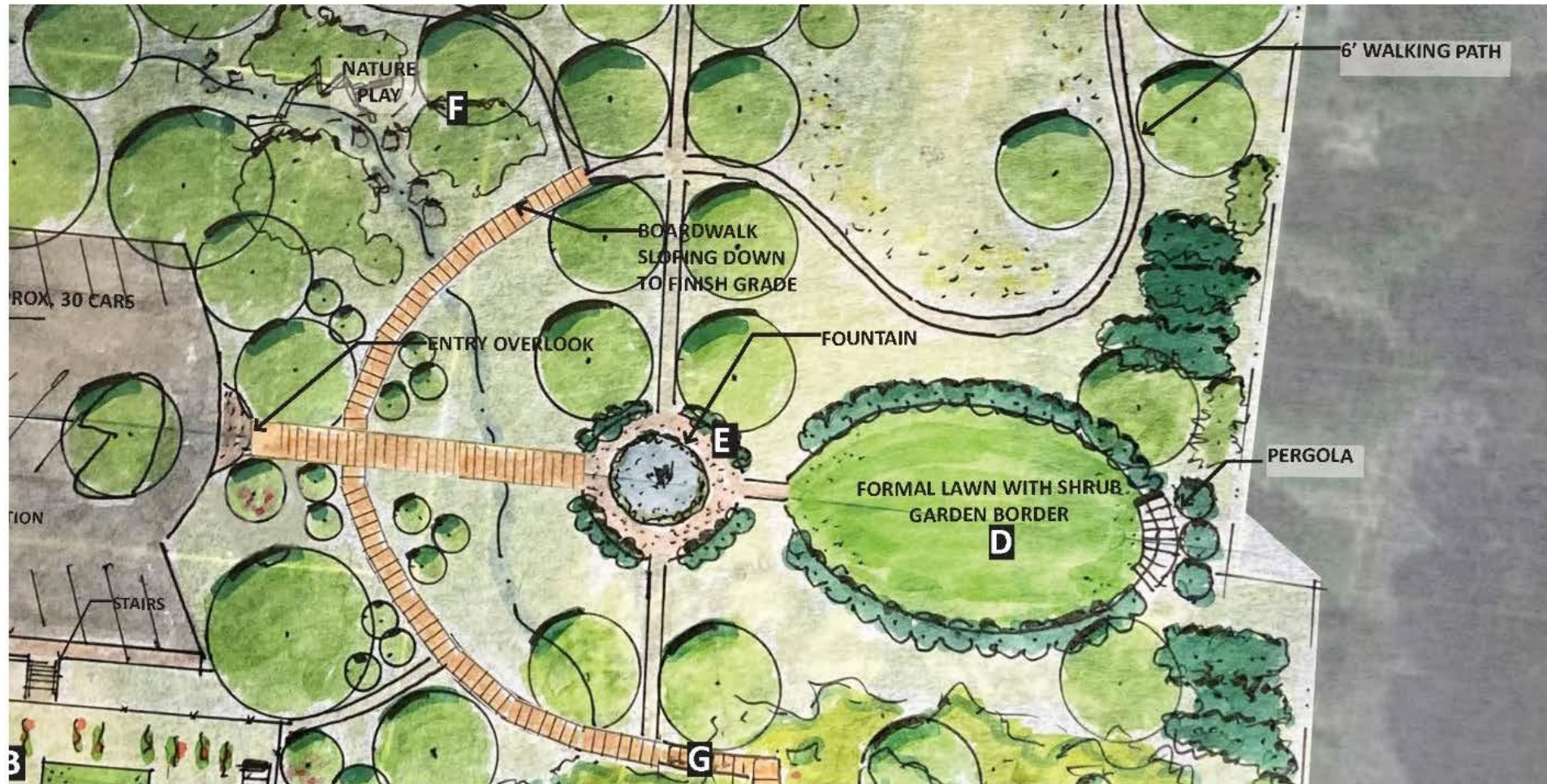

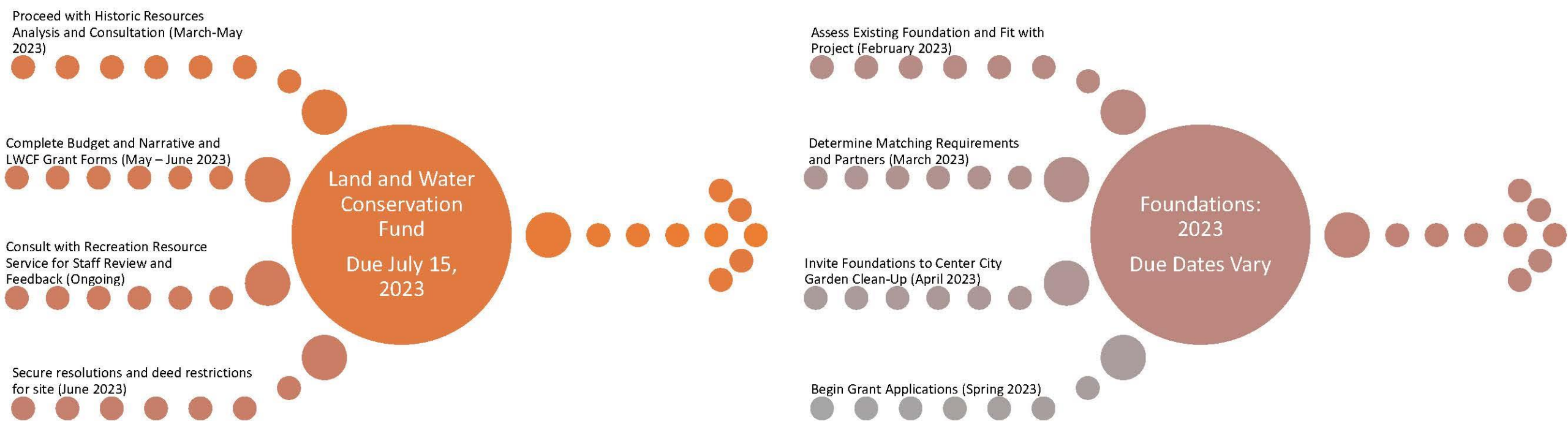
Schedule/Timeline
