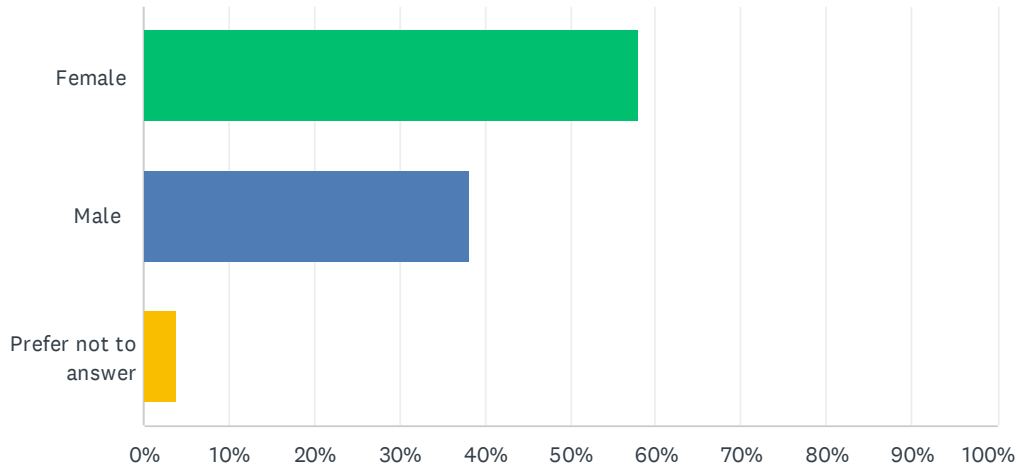


Q1 What is your gender?

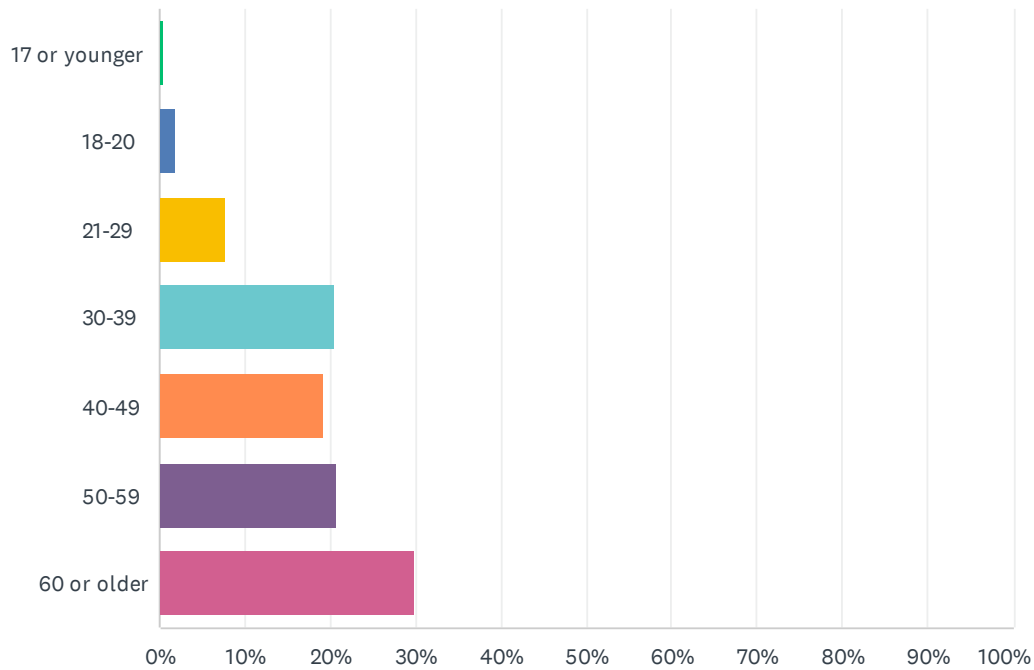

Q2 Which category below includes your age?

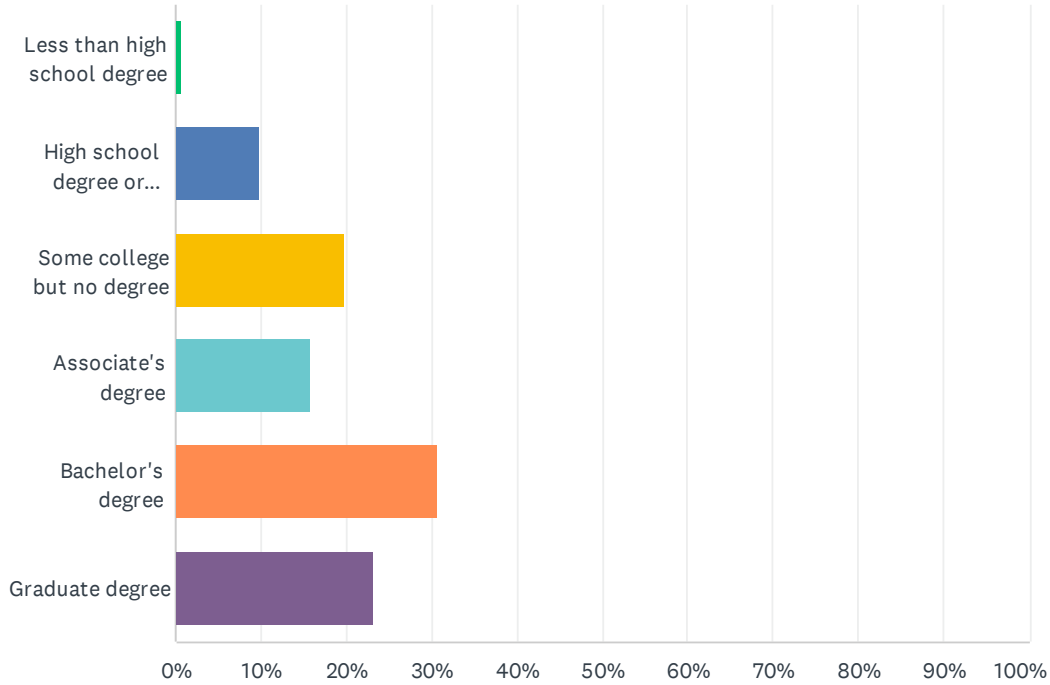

Q3 What is the highest level of school you have completed or the highest degree you have received?

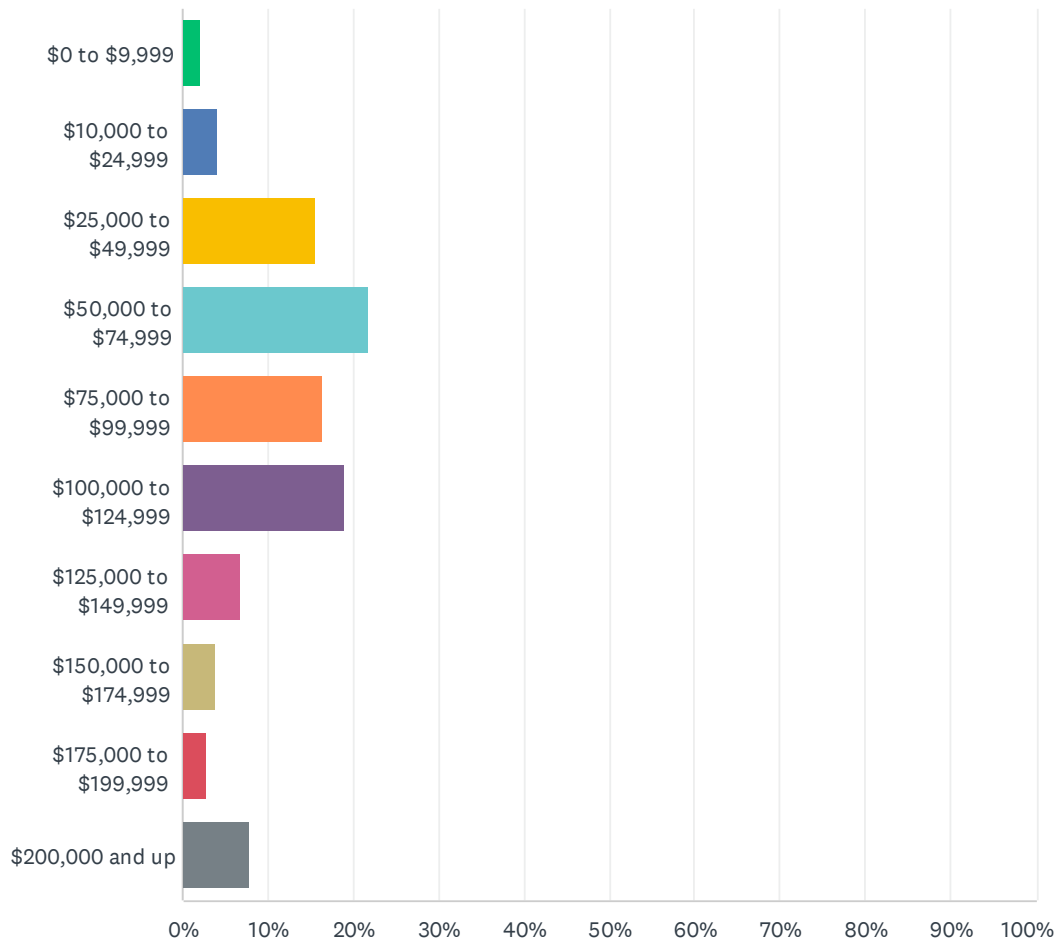

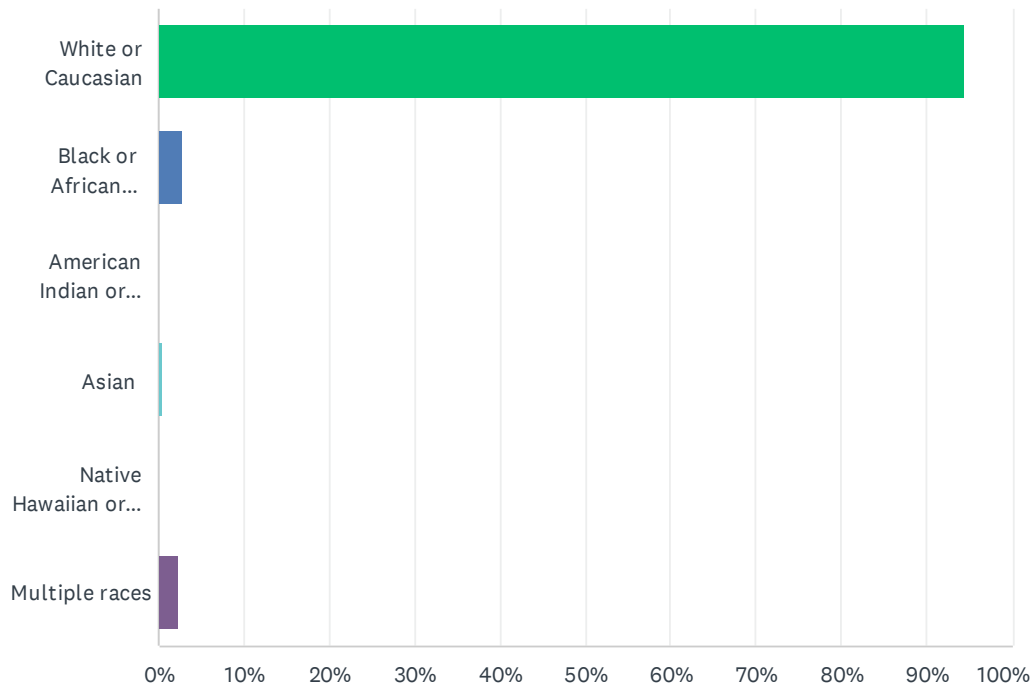

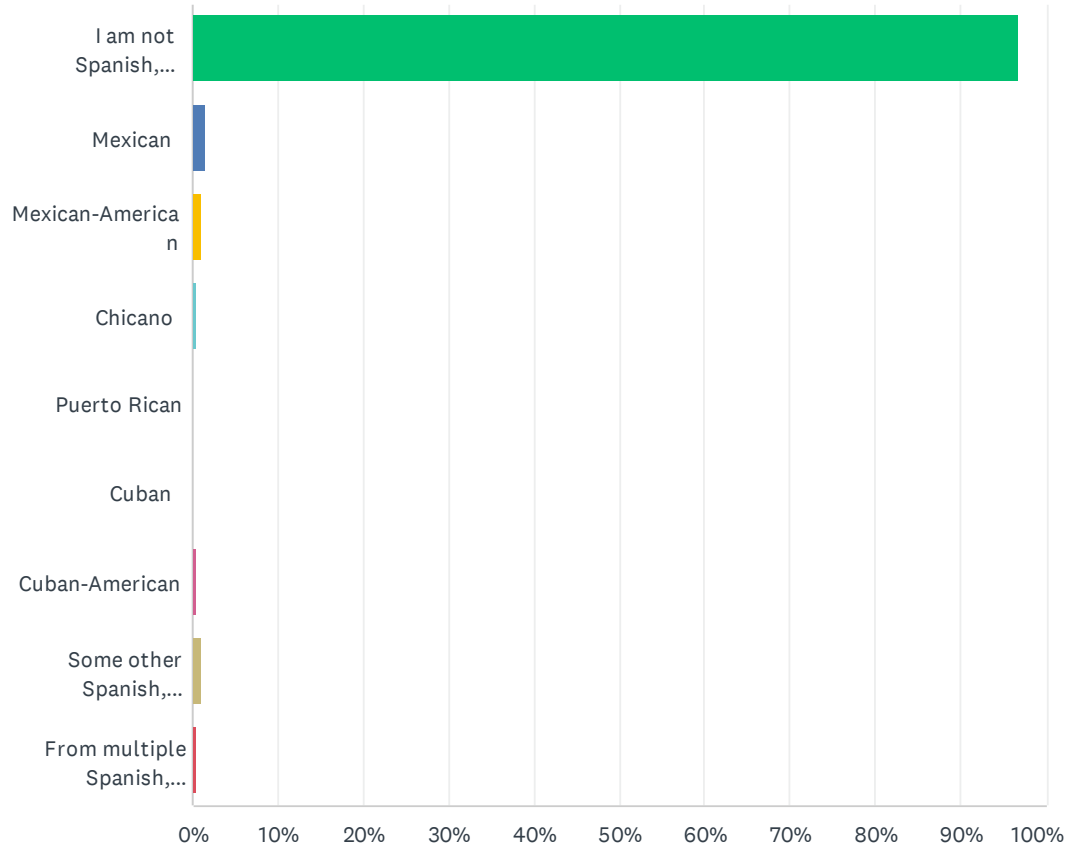

Q6 Are you Spanish, Hispanic, or Latino? If so, with which of the groups below do you identify?

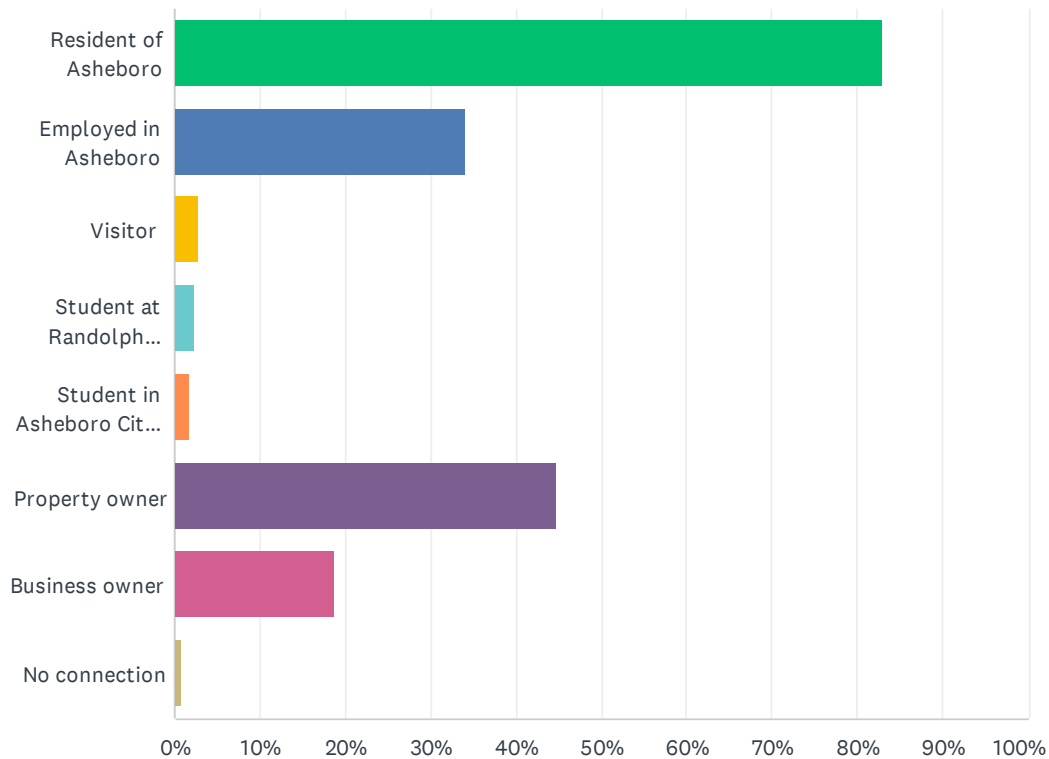

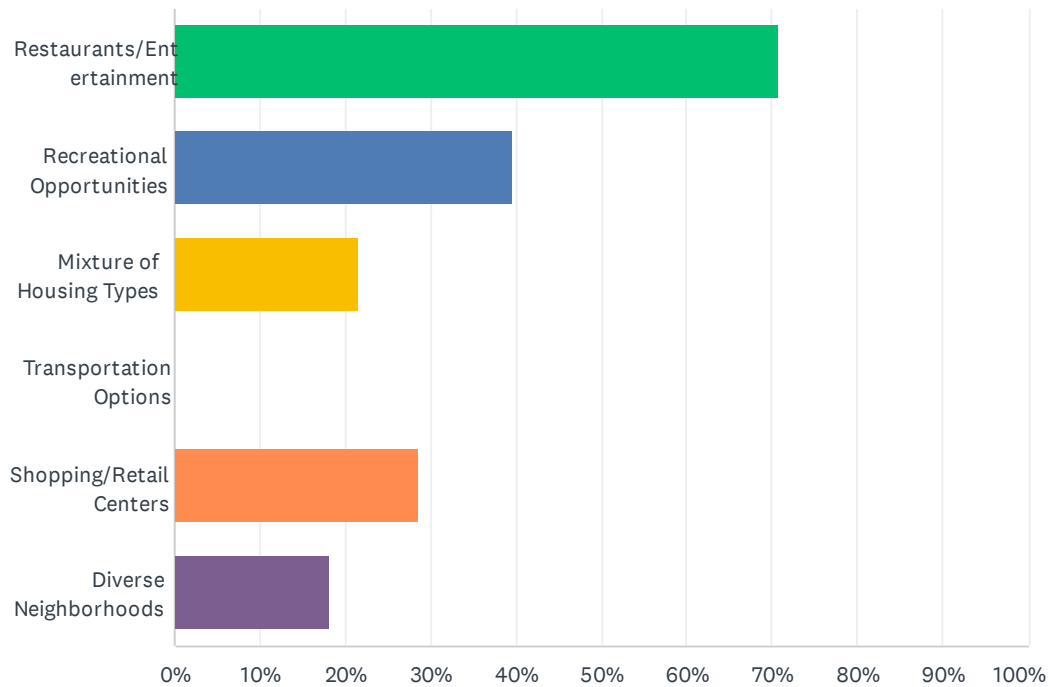

It is very sad that despite living so close to the police department that we never see police driving up and down Worth Street to patrol it. I feel that despite the town's best effort to assist Asheboro in continuing to grow that these efforts will ultimately be fruitless because no one will want to come to a town that is being over ridden by crime. My wife and I both have family that is or have been in law enforcement and we both have a lot of respect for our men and women in uniform. However, I have never in my life seen a police chief be so silent on major crime in the city. Did the police chief even comment publicly earlier this year when two young men died over the span of a few days near the C-Store due to gang activity? No. Did the police chief respond when two elementary schools had to be placed on lockdown because of a shooting in the nearby neighborhood? No. A police chief should be there to reassure the community that their department is doing what they can to keep us a community safe. Sitting back and not speaking is not comforting for the community. Also, it results in increased crime because criminals feel like they can get away with whatever they want to in Asheboro. I am very thankful for Mayor David Smith publicly commenting on some of the criminal activity in the community.
